## Responsibilities of Catholic School Councils per Regulation

- Conduct yearly elections- within the first 30 days (After the completion of our staggered entry dates)
- Hold a minimum of 4 meetings per year and abide by the Code of Ethics
- Hold meetings in school or location accessible to the public (can now take place virtually)
- Keep minutes of the meetings
- All financial transactions must be recorded
- Publish an annual report- submit to principal \& school board
- Consult with principal and parents on matters under consultation by the council
- May engage in fundraising activities according to Board policy
- Parents, minimum of 6 , maximum of 21 (to be elected by parents)
- Parish Representative (appointed by Pastor)
- Community Representative (appointed by council)
- Non-teaching staff 1 (elected by non-teaching staff)
- Teacher Representative (elected by teachers)
- Principal (automatic member)


## Procedures for Voting

- Parents will vote for a maximum of 21 representatives by online secret ballot on Wednesday, October 14th, 2020 if a general election is needed
- A notice to all parent(s)/guardian(s) will announce the results
