- February 2, 2021 (After First Term)- Parents must notify the school administrator by January 25, 2021, of their decision to have their child(ren) return to school
- March 22, 2021 (After March Break)- Parents must notify the school administrator by March 5, 2021, of their decision to have their child(ren) return to school
