Google Meet Guidelines for Parents

Please find below important information regarding Google Meet and its use for live lessons:

- If your child is a remote learner or home for a day or more, they must log in to their Google Classroom by 8:25 am in the morning, or 12:20 pm in the afternoon (just like regular school hours), with their camera on, in order to be marked "present" in the attendance
- All remote learners must have their **camera on** during all Google Meets as teachers are monitoring students.
- If your child is going to be absent, please **report your child's absence** using the Safe Arrival line or app **prior to the 8:25 am cut off time**
- Parents of remote learners are reminded that if your child is engaged in a **live Google Meet**, and their **microphone is on**, that any and all conversations will be **heard in the classroom.** Please refrain from interrupting lessons as they are taking place
- Only the student should be on the camera and microphone
- To protect the **privacy of all of our students do not take any photos or videos of the lessons or materials**; teachers will post the materials on Google Classroom if the students/parents require them
- If you need to speak to the classroom teacher, please call or email them; they will be more than happy to return your call/email
- Please **notify the office** of any requests to change from face to face learning to remote learning or vice versa as students may have to be on a waitlist before making any changes
