Google Meet Guidelines Reminders

Please find below important information regarding Google Meet and its use for live lessons:

- Students must log in to their Google Classroom at approximately 8:25 am and at 12:20 pm (just like regular school hours)
- If your child is going to be absent or late, please **report your child's absence** using the Safe Arrival line or App **prior to the 8:25 am cut off time**
- Parents are reminded that if their child is engaged in a **live Google Meet**, and their **microphone is on**, that any and all conversations will be **heard in the classroom**. Please refrain from interrupting lessons as they are taking place.
- Only the student should be on the camera and microphone

- To protect the privacy of all of our students do not take any photos or videos of the lessons or materials; teachers will post the materials on their Google Classroom if the students/parents require them
- As in a regular classroom, remote learners are expected to show courtesy, respect, and consideration for their teachers and peers
- At all times, where there is concern about content, the parent will contact the teacher through established teacher-parent communication protocol including a phone call or email to the teacher
- Technical support is available to assist parents who may be experiencing technical issues at home.

Asynchronous and Synchronous Learning

- As communicated by the Ministry of Education in Policy 164:
 - Synchronous learning happens in real-time. Synchronous learning involves using text, video, or voice communication in a way that enables educators and other members of the school- or board-based team to instruct and connect with students in real-time
 - o Synchronous learning can involve the use of Google Meets, live chats, and email
 - Asynchronous learning: Learning that is not delivered in real-time. Asynchronous learning
 may involve students watching pre-recorded video lessons, completing assigned tasks, or
 contributing to online discussion boards
- In the event of a teacher's absence and no substitute teacher is available, work will be posted asynchronously so that it can be completed by the student throughout the day


