As we approach the final days of the 2020-2021 school year, I would like to thank our school community for their flexibility, patience, and understanding as we reflect on a unique year at Holy Spirit CES. Student Retrieval Day: Tuesday, June 29th, 2021

On Tuesday, June 29th, 2021, students will be able to retrieve their personal belongings and say goodbye to their peers and classroom teacher. Every class has been assigned a thirty-minute time slot to visit the school. Students, staff, and visitors must follow all public health guidelines that were followed before the school closure. For our students, this includes the wearing of masks for students in grades 1 to 8, social distancing protocols, and proper hand hygiene. We kindly ask that all parents who are on school property also follow the same guidelines.

Before arriving at the school, parents must ensure that their child/children have successfully completed the COVID-19 Self-Assessment: <u>Online Self-Screening Tool</u>. Students are to line-up as they would normally in the morning for school, in their assigned lines. Teachers will take attendance before entering the building. In the event that it is raining, students are to enter from the main entrance of the building and proceed directly to their classes. Students will be dismissed at the end of their assigned time to their designated yard area. Please ensure that you arrive on time for their dismissal.

Our fully remote classes (Ms. Wong and Ms. Fraser's classes) will be meeting for 30 minutes for a virtual goodbye. Please check the teacher's Google classroom for their scheduled time. Furthermore, there will be table set up at the main entrance to return any school related items for parents who have their child in a fully remote class.

Thank you for your cooperation and attention as we hope to ensure a fun, safe, and smooth final day of school for our students and families. If you have scheduled an appointment for the pick-up of your child's items, please ensure that you check-in at the main entrance and that you have successfully completed the COVID-19 self-assessment. If you or your child are experiencing any symptoms, please contact the office to reschedule. Before Arriving

- To be permitted on school grounds, staff, students, and visitors must: 1. Conduct a self-assessment for COVID-19 before arriving at school; and

4. Have not cared for or had known contact with an individual with confirmed COVID-19 or COVID-19 like symptoms (fever, new cough, difficulty breathing).
