Dear Parents and Guardians,

Preparations for a safe return to school includes sharing information with our families and students about safety measures in place for those riding the bus to and/or from Holy Spirit CES. Students and their families should expect that when a child boards their school bus, they will be safe and cared for. This letter aims to provide you with updated bus procedures at this time.

As transportation for students is a privilege, it is imperative that students follow all safety routines and procedures. Should a student fail to follow all safety routines and procedures, they may be asked not to ride the bus and have bus privileges revoked.

Safety Measures

- Students in Grades 1 to 8 will be required to wear a face mask while waiting at the bus stop and while riding their bus unless a special accommodation is required
- While students in Kindergarten are not required to wear a face mask, it is strongly recommended that they do so while waiting at the bus stop and while riding on the school bus
- Please arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled time during the first two weeks of school and ensure physical distancing while waiting and entering onto the bus
- Within the first week of school seating plans for each route will be developed and shared with our school staff and parents
- Where possible, students of the same household will share a seat
- Students will be expected to remain in their seats at all times
- A reminder that if a child is ill, even with mild symptoms, they must remain at home
- Our staff will go over the seating plan with students on their first day of school and will update students of any changes

Covid-19 Protocols

- In consultation with York Region Public Health, all high touch areas of school vehicles will be cleaned by the driver throughout the day as well as a regular deep cleaning
- Where possible, depending on the weather, buses will operate with windows lowered to increase air ventilation
