This past week we welcomed both students, staff, and our parent community back to in-person learning. Please take an opportunity to review the information below for our upcoming week at Holy Spirit CES.

Changes in Modality: Second Term Remote Learning

As previously communicated, the York Catholic District School Board is offering students the option to permanently switch their learning modality for the second term. This change would stay in effect until the end of the school year.

Given the recent school closures, they have extended the deadline to make a permanent change request to **Wednesday**, **January 26**, **2022**. Families wishing to permanently change their child's learning modality from in-person to remote, or remote to in-person, can do so by:

- Calling or emailing (hst@ycdsb.ca) our school office with your change request
- If staff are not able to answer your call, please leave a message with your child's name, grade, and the permanent change you are requesting to remote or in-person

Families can expect the school to follow up and confirm the request by phone or email

IMPORTANT NOTICE: If no permanent change is needed, do not contact the school - no action is required.

Remote Learners

This week, in-person learners were provided with two rapid tests along with instructions. If your family has chosen the temporary remote option and would like their tests, please contact the office to set up a pick-up time and date.

Daily Screening Confirmation Reminder

This is a friendly reminder to complete the Daily Screening Confirmation Form that indicates your completion of the Provincial Child Care Screener

Based on symptoms, if the screening tool advises your child must isolate, please note that all household members of a symptomatic person, regardless of vaccination status, should stay at home for the same length of time the symptomatic person is isolating. Please refer to the screening tool for instructions or refer to ontario.ca/exposed for more information.

If your child has symptoms, but the screening tool does not advise self-isolation, they should remain at home until their symptoms are improving for at least 24 hours (or 48 hours if gastrointestinal symptoms). Your household members do not need to self-isolate.
