Family members can purchase items through the system as well and payment can be made online or by cheque sent to the classroom teacher by Friday, June 9th, 2023. There will only be a limited amount of food available for walk-up. On the day of the event, there will be other on-site food available.

Personally Owned Electronic Devices Information (Cell Phones)
