
## **Unity Prayer**

- Please use the Safe Arrival System if your child(ren) is absent due to inclement weather. Students who cannot attend due to cancelled buses must still be reported absent using the Safe Arrival System.
- Hot Lunch programs at all YCDSB Elementary Schools are cancelled.
- As school transportation is cancelled in the morning, it will not operate in the afternoon.
- Exams, tests, quizzes, excursions/trips, school programs, co-curricular activities, evening presentations, workshops, in-services and parent meetings are cancelled for that day and will be rescheduled.
- Before and After Programs and Childcare Centres in schools make every effort to remain open in inclement weather. However, the decision to open or to close early is up to the discretion of the Child Care Operator.

- Please use the Kiss and Ride pictured below for student drop-off and pick-up

- Please do not block the bus loop (indicated with a white x), as buses must exit
- Do not double park at any time as having students exit in between cars can be dangerous; it also causes congestion in the Kiss and Ride area

- Students are encouraged to walk independently to their designated yard
