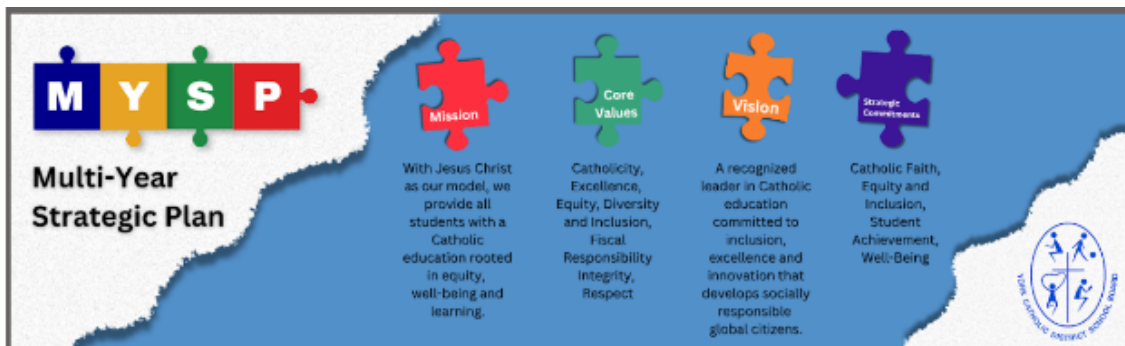

Appropriate Dress Code Reminder

With the warmer weather just around the corner, it is a good time to remind our community of Policy 219A: Appropriate Dress Code. We kindly ask that parents review the following with their children to ensure that the policy is being adhered to.

- Shoulder straps: at least three fingers wide;
- The midriff is not visible
- Garments are to have solid fabric rather than mesh or netting
- Shorts must be longer than the length of the student's arms/hands at their side
- Avoid low-riding pants so that underwear is not visible
- No wearing hats/hoodies in the school building
- No explicit/inappropriate messaging on shirts/sweaters
- Running shoes are required as outdoor/indoor shoes (both for recess safety & Physical Education)

Students will receive verbal reminders, however, if they continue to not follow the dress code, they will be asked to call home for a change of clothes. We hope that with your support these guidelines can be adhered to.

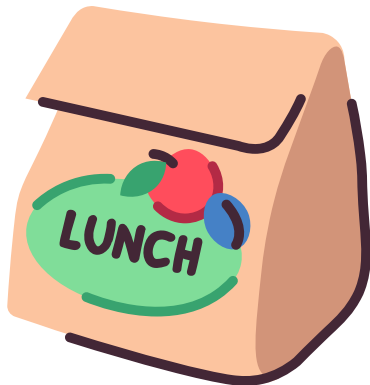
