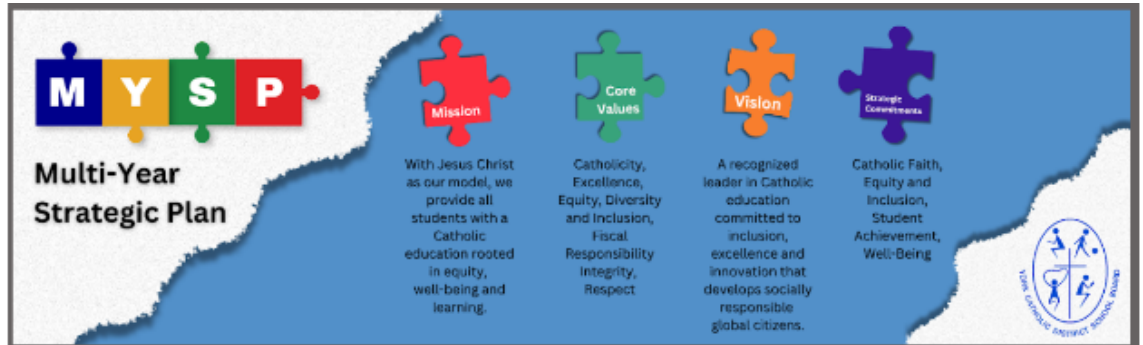

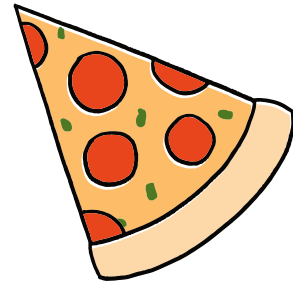


SUMMER OF SHARING FOOD DRIVE
