We are excited to begin our Healthy Snack Program next week. The goal of the program is to support learning and development. There will be approximately 5 snacks per delivery (1 snack = 2 food items from 2 different food groups, one of which must be a fruit or vegetable). Snacks will be delivered by student helpers on **Tuesdays and Thursdays before last recess**.
